- Use recycled construction materials whenever these can be commercially justified
- Keep transport use to a minimum and regularly service vehicles to maintain their efficiency
- Have a full EV company vehicle fleet by September 2023
- Work with suppliers to ensure they recognise and reduce the environmental impact of their products and transportation
- Continually find ways to reduce our energy consumption
- Move to a new office by February 2023 that allows staff to walk, cycle and use public transport to get to work when not working from home
- Uses most low power LED lighting throughout the building and all energy is sourced from renewable suppliers

1.1 Environmental Action Plan

An active carbon monitoring plan to measure and actively reduce our carbon footprint. This plan is being implemented in partnership with Carbon Neutral Britain.

1.2 Energy



Whitewater Display Limited uses 80% low energy LED light bulbs, high insulation and computers are never left on standby overnight or over weekends.

1.3 Water

Whitewater Display Limited have due regard for water saving methods and uses a short- flush system in toilets and has made staff aware of our water saving policy.

1.4 Waste

Waste materials are reused where appropriate and recycled in all other cases.

1.5 Transport

Staff are encouraged to car share when possible, our delivery companies use journey planning to reduce mileage.

We have an EV based company car policy and our aim is that all Company vehicles will be Electric by September 2023.

1.6 Noise/Odour

Whitewater Display Limited regularly measures the noise and odour output from its sites and adjusts such outputs if they fail to comply with regulations.

1.7 Emissions

Our production processes do not release any harmful emissions.

1.8 Construction and Operation

Carbon neutral solutions and providers are favoured when considering new investments.

1.9 Supply Chain

Whitewater Display Limited continuously ensures that our supply chain is as short as it can be, giving us clarity of procedure and process. We encourage our clients and suppliers to adopt our paperless billing policy.
